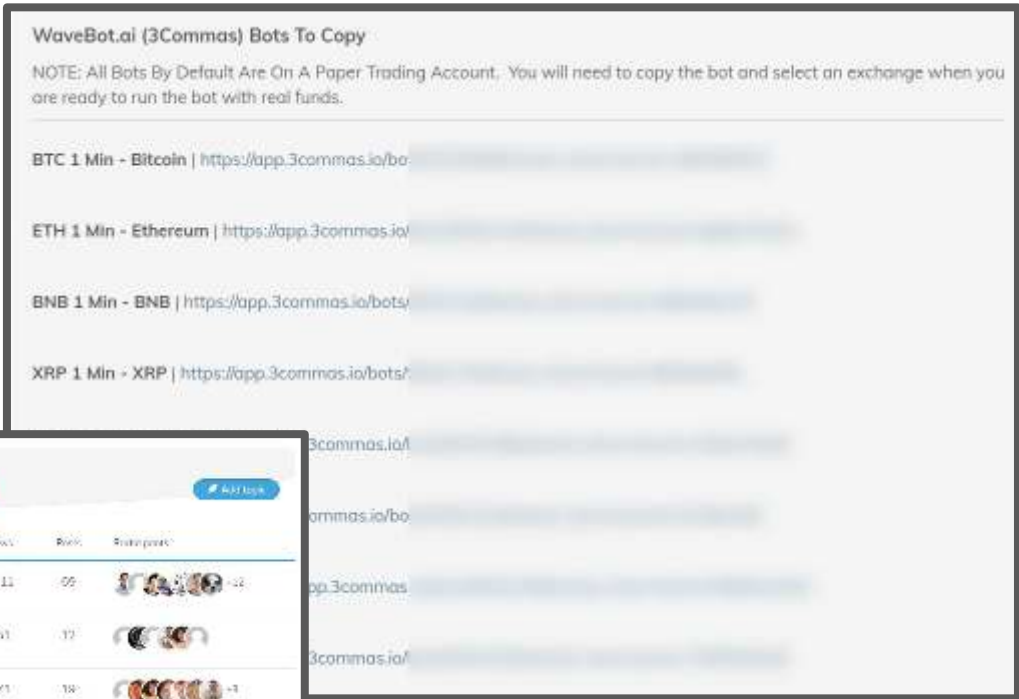





Step 6: Set your “Base Order Size”  
- Working capital





# WaveBot Checklist

Step 11: Copy The TradingView Chart from the “Recommended Pairs”

- BTC/USDT 1 Min
- Make sure you click COPY
- Name it BTC 1 Min
- If you can't see the bars click “AUTO”

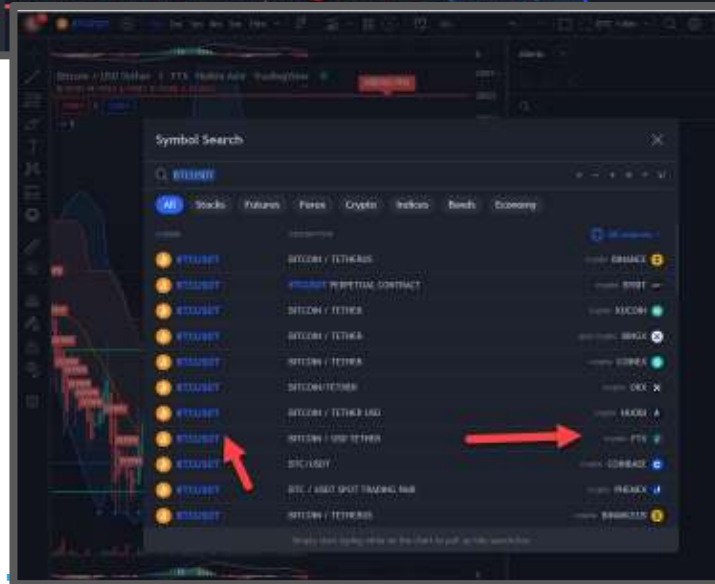


# WaveBot Checklist

## Step 12: Check Your Chart Feed And Timeframe

- BTCUSDT FTX - 1 Min
- Try to match your chart feed to the exchange you are using.
- If there isn't one use Binance or Kucoin

This is important you have your chart setup correctly. By default all copied charts are on Kucoin so if you are using a different exchange you will want to change the feed.



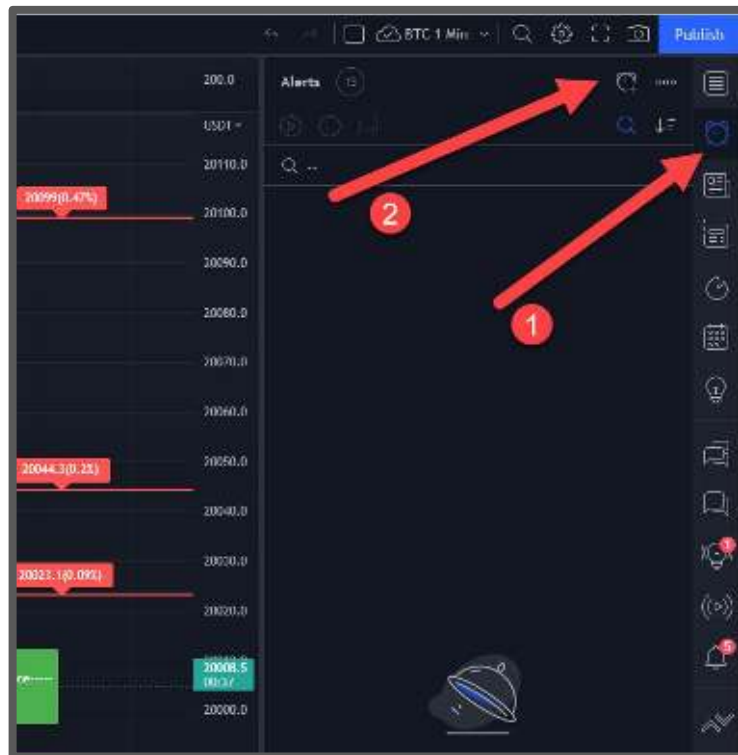
# WaveBot Checklist

## Step 13: Create 3 Alerts

- Signal Down - One Per Bar
- Circle Down - One Per Bar Close
- Diamond Down - One Per Bar Close

It's important that when you create the alert you are on the exact chart you want.

In this example I'm selecting BTC/USDT on the FTX 1 Min Chart

- Signal Down - Once Per Bar

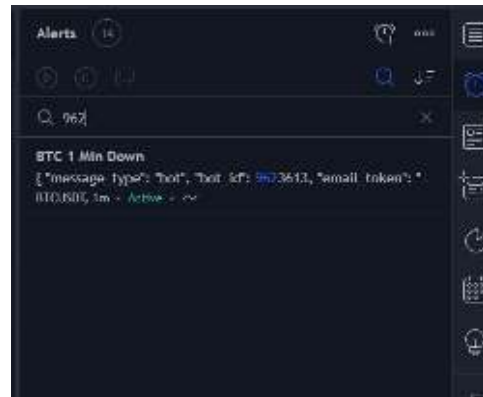

Pro+ accounts will have to edit their bot every 30 days and set the date forward or it will stop working.

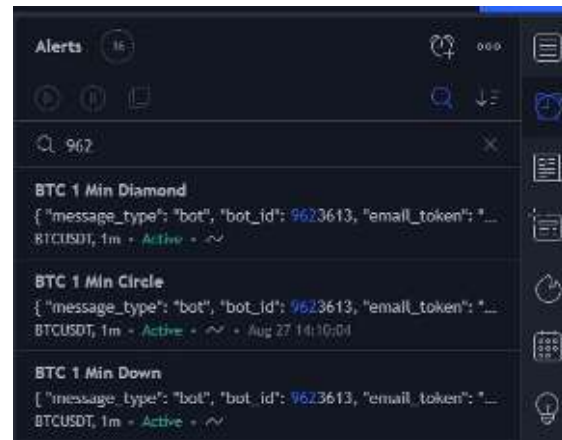

- Make sure you have the Webhook URL in or your bot will not fire off.

Pro+ accounts will have to edit their bot every 30 days and set the date forward or it will stop working.
